Our programme is a mixture of guest lectures, and instructional lectures from both club and external speakers. We also add location shoots, in addition to two internal competitions a year and three external competitions per year with nearby clubs.

You will have the opportunity to enter your pictures in a club setting and have some informal comments from other members, before entering them into club competitions. These competitions are entered anonymously under your Competition Number which will be issued to you by the Secretary.

CLUB RULES

1. The club will be known as the Malton and District Camera Club. It aims for fellowship and promotion of good photography
2. The officials consist of Chairman, Vice Chairman, Hon Treasurer, Hon Secretary, Competitions Secretary, Press Media Officer, Special Events Co-ordinator, Training Co-ordinator who form the Committee. All of whom retire annually.
3. In the event of the resignation of the Chairman, the new chairman will be the Vice Chairman until the following AGM.
4. Five members of the Committee will constitute a quorum
5. The Hon Auditor will be elected each year.
6. Subscriptions as decided at the AGM are due within four weeks of the beginning of the Autumn and Spring sessions.

Visitors are welcome, but after attending four meetings other than open nights, they are expected to become paid up members.

Subscriptions are half price for children under 18 years old at the beginning of the season, Juniors of 16 and under must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

7. The accounts run from April to April and are presented at the AGM.
8. The club cannot accept responsibility for loss of members and visitors equipment.
9. A competition selection committee will consist of five members. A non committee member to be included for each meeting.
10. Propositions for the AGM to be in the hands of the Secretary one month before the AGM.
11. Chairman to hold office up to a maximum of three
